
Introduction

Programme overview

What Are The Costs?

This programme is fully eligible under Erasmus+
KAI staff mobility for training. The total cost of
€1295 includes all seminar sessions, centre visits,
4 nights' accommodation, intercity travel (Dublin–
Cork–Galway–Dublin), all meals, cultural activities,
and a certificate of attendance. Participants are
encouraged to use their existing Erasmus+ mobility
funding to cover the full cost of participation, in line
with their national agency's guidelines.

Dublin

Galway
